

Assessment and Accountability Data Release Timeline Summer 2018

This document provides districts with key dates for major assessment and accountability data reporting milestones during summer 2018. The timeline below provides each district a review period of 10 or more days before public releases, pursuant to Chapter 715 of the Public Acts of 2018. The timeline also allows districts time to thoroughly check data, obtain additional support, and appeal potential errors in the data as necessary. The department will strive to hit these dates; however, these dates are estimates that may vary due to the nature of the data quality assurance process.

Please also note that the dates included in this document are not public dates and are being shared for planning purposes only. **Therefore, do not share these dates publicly.** Additionally, the dates noted here are not the dates for public releases; they are only the dates for release to districts. As we reach various milestones, we will communicate public release timing. Therefore, as you receive data, consider it embargoed until we communicate otherwise.

Additional Details

Week of June 11, 2018: *End-of-Course Student-, School-, and District-Level Data with Performance Levels.* On this date, all data released to the district is embargoed and may not be shared through any public channels. District leadership may share data to school leaders.

Week of July 2, 2018: *All Assessment Data Released to Districts.* On this date, all data released to the district is embargoed and may not be shared through any public channels. District leadership may share data to school leaders. Expect additional guidance and support on purpose and structure of accountability files closer to this date.

Week of July 2, 2018: *District Appeals Window Opens.* Districts may submit formal appeals of accountability data to the department. Additional guidance on how to submit appeals will be provided closer to the beginning of the appeals window.

Week of July 23, 2018: *District Appeals Window Closes.* Districts have until this date and time to submit formal accountability appeals to the department.

Week of Aug. 6, 2018: *Embargoed District and School Designations.* Directors will receive their districts' final accountability determination, as well as notice of any Reward or Priority schools in the district, via an emailed letter. At that time, the determination status is embargoed or may not be publicly shared through any channel. Data files displaying the metrics that are included in determination calculations will be available on the Accountability Application.

Week of Aug. 13, 2018: *2018 Data Loaded in TVAAS Restricted Site.* On the restricted site, districts may find various reports based on user permissions including district, school, and teacher value-added scores as well as scatterplots, college readiness reports, and district and school dashboards. Finally, as data and determination statuses become available, please utilize the following resources to receive support.

1. **Accountability Application:** The accountability application may be accessed [here](#) using Single Sign On (SSO) credentials. This support medium will serve as the central storing station for data releases, announcements, and guidance throughout the accountability process. Each director is given a unique username and password. It is up to the director to share access with the other personnel in their district, and it is up to the district to share data with schools. All password resets must come from the director. Alternatively, directors may request access for district personnel by submitting an application access form with their approval ([here](#)). 2. **Regional Data Analysts:** Districts should utilize the regional data analysts, located in the Centers of Regional Excellence (CORE) offices, for questions pertaining to accountability data. The regional data analysts can help you access, read, and interpret accountability data. In addition, they can field questions pertaining to the methodology used in making accountability calculations.
